<p><b><u>Position Summary:</u></b></p> <p>The Health Coordinator is responsible for ensuring the health and wellness of attendees, volunteers, and staff at Pride Winnipeg events. This role focuses on public health initiatives, sanitation measures, hydration stations, and the overall well-being of festival participants.</p> <p><b><u>Duties &amp; Responsibilities:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Oversee the implementation of health and wellness protocols for all Pride Winnipeg events.</li> <li>• Coordinate hydration stations, cooling areas, and other wellness resources for attendees.</li> <li>• Ensure access to basic medical and hygiene supplies, such as hand sanitizing stations and sunscreen dispensers.</li> <li>• Work closely with the First Aid Coordinator to provide medical support and emergency response planning.</li> <li>• Monitor environmental conditions such as heat and air quality to mitigate potential health risks.</li> <li>• Assist in developing and enforcing sanitation policies for food vendors and public facilities.</li> <li>• Provide health and safety training for volunteers and staff, focusing on preventative measures.</li> <li>• Educate attendees on wellness resources available during the event.</li> <li>• Respond to health-related incidents and escalate concerns to the appropriate medical personnel or emergency responders.</li> <li>• Evaluate the effectiveness of health initiatives and provide recommendations for future events.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Skills/Qualifications:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Background in public health, event safety, emergency response, or a related field.</li> <li>• Experience in health coordination, wellness programming, or first aid services.</li> <li>• Strong organizational and problem-solving skills.</li> <li>• Ability to handle high-pressure situations calmly and effectively.</li> <li>• Excellent communication and teamwork abilities.</li> <li>• Knowledge of public health regulations and sanitation standards.</li> <li>• First Aid &amp; CPR certification (required).</li> </ul>
